to me paid by Solomon K White of Laurens District have granted bargain and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Solomon K White all that tract or plantation of land on which I now live containing 379 acres more or less situate in Greenville District on Gilders Creek of Enoree river Beginning at a Rock by the corner of Jacob Garratts Field on the long Branch & runs S 15 E 13 ch to a Rock by Mrs E Jones Fence thence N 75 E 3.12 on Elizabeth Jones line to the oak stump thence S 87 1/2 E 19 ch to hickory dead & gone thence S 75 E 18.75 to a Post oak Bush 3x3 thence S 27 E 16.25 to a stake on Mrs Jones line S 62 E 18.50 to the oak 3x3 near Georgia Road thence along said road 19.30 to stake in Road thence N 62 W 19.10 to Sourwood on Branch 3+ thence down said Branch to Ash corner 3+ on Mill Road thence along said Road to Rock corner thence on N Westons lands line N 6 W 46.50 to stake thence on Josiah Kilgores line to stake thence N 50 W 5.50 to a stake thence N 83 W 24.50 to a large Gum 3+3+ on long Branch thence up the Meanders of said Branch to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining I do have and to hold all and singular the above described promised to the said Solomon K White his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Solomon K White his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew Strain his heirs and assigns forever and here do hereby bind our selves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Andrew Strain his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs or any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
