Know all men by these presents that I Thomas P Brockman of the State and District aforesaid for the love and affection I have for my daughter Francis C Brockman, I do hereby deed to her and her children the following property to be held by her during her life and after her death to go to her children if she should have any, otherwise that she have full power to will the same to any person that she may choose, Viz. one negro woman named Neala about twenty two years old and her three children & her future increase also one negro boy Jack about sixteen years old which property I hereby convey to the said Francis C Brockman on the terms above specified, and thereby forever release and relinquish the same, and also warrant and forever defend the title for which I bind my self my heirs Executors Administrators &c Given under my hand and seal this the 18th day of November Eighteen Hundred & fifty (1850)

Know all men by these presents that I James McMakin of Spertenburg District in the aforesaid State in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and fifty nine Dollars to me in hand paid by Alston Waller of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alston Waller a certain Tract or parcel of land lying in Greenville District and State aforesaid on the waters of North Greens Creek beginning at a chestnut oak running N 76 3/4 E 32.83 to a N.O. thence S 84 3/4 E 57.50 to a N.O. stump thence S 70 E 10.93 to a chestnut gow, thence S 30 E 12.14 to chestnut, thence S 61 3/4 W 30.00 to a stake thence N 28 W 10.25 to a chestnut thence N 30 W 7.25 to a Hickory, gow, thence N 53 W 39.00 to the beginning chestnut containing One Hundred & fifty three Acres more or less adjoining lands of W A Ward Reubin Bowden & others. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise ^{incident or} appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alston Waller his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Alston Waller his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
