 Know all men by these presents that we Hugh W Botkin and Narcissa his wife of Dubois County in the State of Indiana do hereby constitute and appoint Robert B Crawford of the County of Madison and State of North Carolina to be our true and lawful Attorney for us and in our name and behalf to transact all our business of any kind or nature whatsoever within the State of South Carolina for us and in our name and behalf to sue for collect and receive all debts dues and demands now due and payable to us or which at any time hereafter may be due and payable to us to sell all lands slaves goods and matters of which we are owners or have any share or interest within said State of South Carolina and for that purpose to sign seal deliver and execute all necessary Deeds Bills of Sale and other instruments and generally to do and perform all matters and things which may be requisite to make valid and legal sales of all our property in said State of South Carolina with the same powers to all intents and purposes as we do hereby ratify and confirm what ever our said attorney shall lawfully do in our names and for our uses in the premises. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 1st day of September A.D. 1859 signed sealed and delivered in presents Hugh W Botkin of William B Rose Robert A Brenton & Narcissa Botkin

 Be it remembered that on the 1st day of September 1859 before me the undersigned Stephen Rose a Justice of the Peace in and for said County of Dubois personally appeared Hugh W Botkin and Narcissa his wife who severally acknowledged the execution of the foregoing Power of Attorney for the purposes therein expressed and thereupon the said Narcissa wife of said Hugh W Botkin was by me privately examined separate and apart from her said husband touching Execution thereof and she declared that she voluntarily assents to the same and that she did execute the same freely voluntarily and without compulsion or restraint upon either part of her said husband or any person whatsoever.  Know all men by these presents that I George W Crawford of Estill County Kentucky have this day nominated constituted and appointed my Brother Robert B Crawford of the County of Madison in the State of North Carolina my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name to ask for demand receive collect and receipt for any and all manner of property personal real mixed or otherwise which may be due owing or coming to me in any manner whatever either by descent devise or otherwise in the State of South Carolina and particularly from the Estate of Robert Benson or his wife Nancy Benson my Grand father & Grand mother or from their lawful representatives of Greenville District or otherwise or elsewhere in said State of South Carolina to take any and every legal and necessary step for me and in my name to collect and obtain for me either by compromise Arbitration Suit or otherwise or any other lawful mode whatever may be due owing or coming to me either in money negroes or other personal Estate or any other kind or character of property from the persons named or any other person or persons whatever in said State of South Carolina and generally to do and perform every needful and necessary act or acts touching the matters and things herein contained for me & in my name & on my behalf and whatever legal and necessary act my said attorney may or shall do in the premises shall be binding on me
