

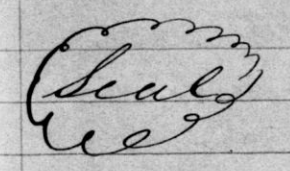
Signed before me and solemnly sworn to by Wm. Statham & W. R. Powell

Know ye that in consideration of your integrity and skill, full power is hereby given to you or any two or more of you to take the renunciation of Mrs Emma H. Green wife of G. W. Green of Gallabuska County in the State of Mississippi of her Dower in the premises described in the deed herunto annexed from the said G. Washington Green to James C. Furman; and for this purpose you will cause the said Mrs Emma H. Green to appear before you and you will examine her privately and separately, apart from all other persons and if upon said Examination she shall freely declare that she does freely voluntarily and without any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever renounce release and forever relinquish unto J. C. Furman his heirs and assigns all her interest and estate and also all her right and claim of Dower of in and to all and singular the premises described and conveyed in the deed aforesaid. Then you shall take under her hand a certificate of her renunciation as aforesaid in the form of a declaration upon private examination as aforesaid, which certificate authenticated by your hands and seals you shall annex to this writ.  
And further to take probate of the execution of said deed, and for this purpose you shall cause one of the subscribing witnesses of the deed aforesaid to appear before you and having administered to him as you are thereby fully authorized to do, on oath or solemn affirmation according to the form of his religious persuasions, that his affidavit is true, you shall take under his hand an affidavit that he was personally present and saw G. W. Green sign seal and deliver the deed aforesaid for the uses and intents therein expressed and that he and the other subscribing witnesses signed their names thereto as witnesses of the due execution, which affidavit authenticated under your hands and seals, you shall annex to this writ. & Having certified under your hands and seals the due

Execution of this writ and verified the same by the oath of one of you before some Magistrate who is authorized by the laws of your State to administer an oath, and whose official signature may be properly authenticated, you shall carefully return this writ, together with your proceedings thereon to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions for Greenville District in the State aforesaid to be duly recorded. Herein fail not Witness
