District and State aforesaid send Greeting Whereas by virtue  
 of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common  
 Pleas held for the District of Greenville tested the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty  
 five at the suit of W. G. Smith to me directed commanding  
 me of the goods and chattles lands and tenements of James S. Smith  
 to levy the sum of Two hundred dollars damages and costs I have seized  
 and taken of the lands and tenements of the said James S. Smith all that  
 certain piece parcel and tract of land containing Eighty five acres situate  
 and being in the District of Greenville adjoining lands of B. McMaon  
 John Cox and others. And whereas the said premises with their appur-  
 tenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of Fieri  
 Facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue and  
 purchased by Howland Cox of the District of Greenville for the sum of Eighty five  
 dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor. Now Know ye that  
 I W.A. McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias  
 to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute of  
 in such cases made and provided, and for and in consideration of the  
 said sum of Eighty five dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be  
 paid by the said Howland Cox the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby  
 acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents  
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said Howland Cox his heirs and
