Ross for and in consideration

of the sum of Four hundred & twenty seven dollars to me
in hand paid by Robert Vaughn of the District & State
aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and released
unto the said Robert Vaughn a certain tract or parcel
of land, Situate, in the District and State aforesaid
on Bigby branch waters of Brushy Creek Onome River
containing Fifty Eight and a half acres be the same more
or less beginning at a white oak 3+ near ford of branch
running S 5 3/4 W 12.74 chs to a stake thence S 16 3/4 W 15.13
chs to a span oak 3+ 3+ new thence S 26 1/4 E 13.07 chs to a Pine 3+ 3+
new thence S 76 E 29.96 chs to a B.O 3+ c.m 3+ 3+ new thence N 20
W 9.78 chs to a B.O 3+ dead thence N 25 W 2.85 chs to a stake thence
N 20 W 20.20 chs to a stone thence N 56 W 9.79 chs to the beginning
together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said Robert Vaughn his heirs and assigns forever, I do
hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administra-
tors to warrant & forever defend all and singular the
premises above mentioned unto the said Vaughn his
heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and every
other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the

Lucy Stokes Deed South Carolina 883
Greenville District
Whenas Thomas Edwards of the
County of Culpepper in the State

of Virginia on the 23^d day of February A D 1791 executed
a deed of two Slaves named Rebecca and Sophia and
their increase to William Edwards and Charles Wickliff
in trust to and for the following uses and purposes
to wit for the said William Edwards and Charles
Wickliff their heirs and assigns to receive the hire
of the said Slaves Rebecca and Sophia and their in-
crease and to pay the money arising therefrom to
Franky Wickliff for her support use and behoof during
her life ~~and~~ after her death that the said Slaves Rebecca
and Sophia and their increase shall be and remain
to the sole proper use and behoof of Lucy Wickliff
her heirs and assigns forever, that the said Franky
Wickliff enjoyed his life estate in said Slaves and
their increase and that the said Lucy Wickliff
on the death of said tenant for life become entitled
in fee to said Slaves and their increase to her sole proper
use and behoof and that she having intermarried with
John Stokes late of the District and State aforesaid he
reduced said Slaves and their increase to possession
and in his lifetime sold some of them and by his last
Will and Testament executed prior to his death dis-
posed of the ballance of said Slaves and their increase
and lately departed this life leaving said Will in full
force which has since been admitted to probate, that
by the provisions of said Will the testator gave a
portion of said Slaves to Lucy Stokes his widow together
with other personal property and a valuable real estate
and the remainder of said Slaves to other Legates named
in said Will, Now Know all men by these presents
that I Lucy Stokes widow of the said John Stokes having
liberally provided for me in his said Will and being desirous
to take under the provisions of his said Will and relinquish
all claim that I have either in Law or Equity arising
under the trust due aforesaid, do hereby express and declare
