Whereas Joseph Barton et al on or about the seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine exhibit their Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against Solomon L Barton for the partition of the real estate of William Barton deceased, and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at full Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudge and decree that the said real estate should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear
