of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid by Abner Walker of the State and District aforesaid here bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain sell and release unto the said Abner Walker a tract of land situated in said District on a small branch of Rocky Creek of Enoree River adjoining Land of Isaac Walker & King Bayles Smith David Vaughn and others containing Fifty Acres more or less Beginning on a Stake & 87 1/4 W 81.55 to a Line & thence S 56 3/4 W 28.50 to a Stake & thence S 77 1/2 E 3.88 to a Spanish Oak Stump thence S 55 1/2 E 6.35 to a Stake & thence S 54 E 18.45 to a Red Oak & thence N 75 1/4 E 8.06 to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Abner Walker his heirs and assigns, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Abner Walker his heirs and assigns against my self and heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, Witness my hand and seal this the tenth day of February 1860 J S Shackston W A Hudson & Alley Vaughn

Creek and runs N 30 W 49.50 to a Stake & thence S 74 W 24.50 to a Hickory & thence S 36 E 47.50 to a W oak & on the creek thence the S creek to be the line down to the beginning of woods & Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the S premises belonging or in anywise incident, To have & to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the only proper use & purposes of the S Abner Walker his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors administrators & assigns to warrant & for ever defend the above premises unto the S Abner Walker his heirs & Co against my self my heirs & Co and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Signed sealed and delivered in presence of
