Anderson of Spartanburg District & the State aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and release unto the said W^m H. Anderson all that tract or parcel of land deeded by George Crymes to James Anderson on the 5th of Feb 1842 when upon the aforesaid George Crymes then lived beginning at a small Pine or Stake on Josiah Kelgons line E 41° to a red oak 3x3 in an old road, thence S 42° E 33.50 to a white oak bush 3x on land now belonging to James Anderson, thence on the line N 16° E to Gilders Creek thence down said Creek to personman 3x and thence N 36° E 17.50 to poplar stump thence N 25° W 6 to a beach corner on Enome river thence up the meanderings of Peters creek to a Rock at the bluff opposite when the lot is now and just
