 the said George W. Curnton all that plantation or tract
 of land containing three hundred & twenty five acres more
 or less situate and lying in the State and District aforesaid
 beginning on a stake 3^x and running thence N 65° W 7.40
 to a stake 3^x thence S 30° W 22 to a stake thence S 27° W 12.70
 to a stake 3^x thence N 60° W 46.84 to a point 3^x thence west 9.90
 to a stake 3^x thence S 17° W 57.60 to a stake 3^x thence N 79° E
 54.75 to stake 3^x thence N 77 1/2° E 16.80 to a Black oak 3^x thence
 S 18° E 23 to a point 3^x thence N 27 3/4° E 55.80 to a post oak stump
 3^x thence to the beginning. Together with all and singular
