 granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elijah
 Pike jun all that Lot piece and parcel of Land lying and
 being in the District and State of aforesaid on the waters
 of Laurel Creek waters of Rudy River Beginning at a stake
 on Butters line near Road & running thence N 59 3/4 E 8.00
 to a Sawerwood 3+3+ new thence down the meanders
 of a Branch to a white oak dead on edge of road & some
 fifty links from Branch thence S 28 1/2 W 2.62 to a stone
 thence N 30 W 4.85 to the beginning. Together with all and
 singular the Rights members and appurtenances to the
 said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
 appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
 the premises before mentioned unto the said Elijah Pike
 jun and to his heirs and assigns forever and I do
 hereby bind my self & my heirs executors and administra-
 tors to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said Elijah Pike and to his
 heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every
 other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof
