 To For
 J J Underwood Land Greenville District
 Know all men by these presents
 that I A W Jackson of Greenville
 in the State aforesaid for and in the consideration of the
 Sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by J J
 Underwood of the said State and District have granted
 bargained sold and released and by these presents do
 grant bargain sell and release unto the said J J
 Underwood all that piece parcel and lot of Land lying
 in Greenville District on Rosins Creek waters of Middle
 Lyger River and bounded as follows, Viz, beginning on
 a stake on a Road called the Jourdan Road running
 thence East 48 chains to a post oak 3/4 thence N 60 E 8
 chains more or less to Rosians Creek thence with the
 meanders of the Creek a stake to morrows line on line 87
 chains thence with said line W to a Hickory on Jourdan
 Road thence with said Road S 28 E 37 chains to the beginning
 containing One hundred acres more or less. To have and
 to hold the above granted premises unto him the said
 J J Underwood his heirs and assigns for ever, and
 I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and adm-
 inistrators to warrant and for ever defend all and
 singular the said premises unto the said J J Underw-
 ood the heirs and assigns against me and my heirs
 and any person or persons whosoever lawfully claim-
 ing or to claim the same or any part thereof
 Witness my hand and seal this Twenty third day of
 July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and sixty and in the 85 year of the sovereignty and
 Independence of the United States of America,
