 To For Greenville District  
 Zadoc P. Hudson Land Know all men by these presents

of the State and District aforesaid in consideration  
 of the sum of Nine hundred and ninety dollars  
 to us in hand paid by Zadoc P. Hudson of the  
 same State and District have granted bargained  
 sold and released unto the said Zadoc P. Hudson  
 a certain tract or plantation of land situated  
 in the District aforesaid on both sides of Mountain  
 Creek of Enore River Beginning on a Post oak by  
 the Hodge road, thence N 77° W 4 chains & 44 links  
 to Pine thence N 73 3/4° W 10 chains & 95 links to a Post  
 Oak Stump thence N 65° W 7 chains & 60 links to a  
 Dogwood thence S 20 1/2° W 30 chains & 27 links to a Post  
 Oak thence N 86° W 5 chains & 40 links to a Stone thence  
 S 2 E 5 chains & 85 links to a Pine thence S 24 1/2° E 4 chains  
 & 5 links to a Sweet Gum on a branch of Mountain  
 Creek thence down the meanders of said branch  
 to Mountain Creek thence up the meanders  
 of said Creek to the Hodge Road thence along  
 said Road to the beginning corner containing  
 One hundred and Ten acres more or less.

Originally granted to James Barnes and from  
 him to Joshua Hawkins by deed, together with all and  
 singular the rights members hereditaments and app-  
 urtenances to the said premises belonging or in  
 any wise incident or, or appertaining. To have and  
 to hold the said premises unto the said Zadoc  
 P. Hudson his heirs Executors administrators  
 or assigns from us our heirs Executors administrators  
 or assigns or any other person or persons whomsoever  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
