presents that I David C Garrison of said District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two shous and Dollars to me paid by Ann B Dacus of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and ~~and release~~ unto the said Ann B Dacus a plantation or tract of land situated on Bakers creek waters of Reedy River and part of three original grants the first to Cawader Jones the second to Robert Gillam the third to Charles Pope and Transfurd by divers conveyances to David C Garrison and by him to the said Ann B Dacus beginning on a hickory on the edge of the old field on ~~if~~ by bargain  $\frac{3}{4}$  thence S 28 W 24 chains 5 links to a stake thence N 62 W 3 chains 80 links to a stake thence S 28 W 24 chains 75 links to a post oak  $\frac{3}{4}$  thence S 50 E 33 chains 30 links to a stake thence N 55 E 57 chains 30 links to post oak dead  $\frac{3}{4}$  thence N 15 E 2 chains to stake or Spanish oak thence N 55 W 20 chains to creek thence continuing the same course to the begining corner making in in all two hundred and thirty acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
