 of fifty dollars to us in hand paid by R. E. Compton
 of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina
 the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge have
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said R. E.
 Compton all our right claim interest and
 title as legatees and distributees of the estate
 of Mary Taylor deceased late of Greenville District
 in the State of South Carolina in all that certain
 piece parcel and tract of land lying and
 being in Greenville District on the waters of
 Syger River adjoining lands of William McKinney
 James McKinney et al, containing fifty acres
 more or less on the east side of the State road
 leading from Greenville Court House to Hodge
 being the same tract that was conveyed by Dr. Wilborn
 Barton to Mary Taylor during her life time
 Together with all and singular the rights mem-
 bers and hereditaments and appurtenances belonging
 or in any wise incident or appertaining to said
 premises, To have and to hold all and singular
 the premises unto the said R. E. Compton his heirs,
 administrators Executors or assigns forever and
 we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and
 administrators to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said
 R. E. Compton his heirs and assigns against us and
 our or any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 Witness our hands and seals this sixteenth day of November
