 to me paid by James Garrison of the same State
 and District have granted bargained sold and rehas-
 ed and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and release unto the said James Garrison all
 that plantation and tract of land wherein I now
 live containing Eighty Nine acres more or less in
 the State and District aforesaid on a branch of
 the little Rudy Fork of Rudy River the same being
 part of a tract originally granted to Abner Bishop
 thence conveyed to Daniel Ford then by inheritance
 to James McElroy by him to John C Fowler by him
 to Lucke C Rice and by the said James Lattefield and
 now by the said James Lattefield to the said James
 Garrison - beginning on a dogwood & near John
 Ford's Spring thence S 59° E 1975 to a Red oak & John
 Smith's corner thence N 56° E 10.72 to a Stake & thence
 N 8 W 20 to a stone & on Fork Shoal church lot thence
 E 3 to a Stake & on same thence S 8 E 1.67 to a stone & on
 same thence E 1.08 to a Post oak & on same thence N 11.
 E 2.50 to a Sweet Gum & on same thence N 81 E 2.50 across
 the old spring to a stone & on same thence S 2.75 to a stone
 & on same lot thence S 38 E 8.95 to a Post oak & on same
 church lot thence N 30 1/2 E 26.80 to a stone & thence S 78 W
 28 to a stone & thence S 58 W 2.80 to a Poplar & thence
 S 82 W 2 to a White oak stump & thence S 89 W 4 to a stone
 & thence S 29 W 12.75 to a Post oak & thence S 36 W 16.75
 to the beginning as exhibited by a survey & plot made by
 Col L H Shumate April 13th 1857, bounded by lands
 belonging to Willis Chandler Estate of McBerry deceased
 John Smith Fork Shoal Church Dr D D Moon and Col
 S E Bell are together with all and singular the rights
 members tenements hereditaments and appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
 the premises above mentioned to the said James Garri-
 son his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby
 bind my self my heirs executors and administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the above premises to the said James Garrison his
 heirs and assigns against my self & my heirs and against
 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
 the same or any part thereof, witness my hand & seal this the
 Fourteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and fifty and in the eighty fourth year of American Independence
