Fowler of the aforesaid State and District for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to me paid by B I Brockman of Spartanburg District in South Carolina hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said B I Brockman a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville District and in the State aforesaid on the waters of Enoree River Beginning at white oak corner on the branch on Clark line thence up said branch to a stake on Spartanburg road thence along said west to a rock on the west corner of Cooper fence thence along said fence to Holly on Bishops line thence along said line to a rock corner in the old field or a Sycamore in said old road thence along said road to the beginning corner on the branch. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To Have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said B I Brockman his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above said premises unto the said B I Brockman his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs Executors and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
