

Alfred Brown Deed . South Carolina
To Henry Rains For Land Greenville District

Know all men by these presents that I Alfred Brown for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Rains have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain grant sell and release unto the said Henry Rains a certain tract or parcel of Land situate in the District and State aforesaid on Cambreak Branch waters of Enoree River containing Eighty six and one half acres the same being part of a tract of land formerly owned by William Taylor and conveyed by him to Dudley Howell and by Dudley Howell to Thomas Howell and by Thomas Howell to Thomas Shackley and by Thomas Shackley to Samuel Rains a free colored man and Robert Duncan his Guardian and by Samuel Rains a colored man and Robert Duncan his Guardian to Emily Green and Emily Green to George W Martin and by said G W Martin to myself beginning at a Spanish oak 3+3+0m thence running S 1 W 39.12 chs to P. O 3+0m thence S 70 1/4 W 19.15 chs to P. O 3+0m thence N 10 W 18 50 ch to Maple 3+0m thence N 6 1/2 E 29.75 chs to stake 3+0m thence S 82 1/2 E 18.22 chs to Spanish oak the beginning Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Henry Rains his heirs and assigns forever. I Alfred Brown do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry Rains his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this Tenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty and in the Eighty Fifth year of the Independence.
