 To For Know all men by these presents  
 Joseph H Coleman Land That I Elisha N Coleman of Greenville  
 District in the aforesaid State in  
 consideration of Six Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid  
 by Joseph H Coleman of Greenville District in the State aforesaid  
 have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph  
 H Coleman all that tract or parcel of land situate lying  
 and being in Greenville District and State aforesaid on both  
 sides of Enoree River being part of the tract I purchased from  
 Booker Bomar beginning in the center of a ditch on the lower  
 line of said tract near the bridge on the road leading to Marsh  
 -banks Mill and runs N 29 3/4 W 28.30 to a Spanish oak 3+3+ thence  
 S 60 W 30.90 to a Stone 3+ thence S 28 3/4 E 18.43 to a Spanish oak 3+3+  
 on the side of the old Ashville Road thence along said road S 17 1/2  
 W 7.30 to a Stone 3+ Red oak gone thence S 69 1/5 W 18.12 to a Stone 3+  
 thence S 21 E 11.00 to a Pine 3.0 m & 3+3+ n thence N 68 E 28.30 to a Stone  
 3+ at the edge of the bottom thence N 48 E 10.60 to a bend in the large  
 ditch of the River thence down with said ditch N 49 E 18.00 to the  
 beginning containing one hundred and twenty eight and one  
 half acres more or less it being the plantation on which Joseph  
 H Coleman now lives, Together with all and singular the rights  
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and  
 to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
 Joseph H Coleman his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby  
 bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
 the said Joseph H Coleman his heirs and assigns against  
 me and my heirs and against every other person or persons  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
 Witness my hand and seal this seventeenth day of May  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
 sixty and in the eighty fourth year of the Sovereignty and  
 Independence of the United States of America
