 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
 unto the said Thomas A Atkison a certain piece or  
 parcel of land lying and being in the District and State  
 aforesaid and on the South East Side of the Greenville  
 Road Beginning at the road on a Stone and runs thence  
 S 62 W 3.07 to Stone, thence S 21 1/2 E 31.75 to Stone thence N 75 E  
 13.00 to Pine down thence N 9 E 10.50 to Stone on the road, thence  
 up the meanders of said road to the beginning containing  
 thirty four and half acres be the same more or less, and  
 bounded by lands of William Bramlett Pinkney Vaughn  
 the Greenville road, Together with all and singular  
 the rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances  
 thereto belonging or in anywise incident or appertai-  
 ning, To have and to hold all and singular the said  
 premises unto the said Thomas A Atkison his heirs and  
 assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs  
 executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend  
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas  
 A Atkison his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs
