 William Bates Esq Land this indenture made the first day
 of September in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty two between
 William Mc Thomas Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable
 Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court
 House in the said State of the one part and William Bates
 Thomas Mc Coy and Henry P Hammett of the other part
 Whereas Thomas of Turner and Mahala Mc Turner on or about
 the Fifth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and sixty two exhibited their bill of complaint
 in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the
 said State against Barksdale & Garrison et al, for the
 partition of land held in common by Barksdale & Garri-
 son and the late Silas Mc Turner, and the cause being
 at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard
 at Chambers in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and sixty two when the said Court after full
 hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises
 did order adjudge and decree that the said land should
 be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the said
 Court, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their
 decretal order as by reference in the registry of the said
 Court, will appear, and the said William Mc Thomas as Com-
 missioner of the said Court after having duly advertised
 the said Land for sale by public outcry on the first day of
 September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and sixty two did then openly and publicly and according
 to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of the said Land
 below described unto the said William Bates Thomas Mc Coy
 and Henry P Hammett for three thousand Eight hundred
 and sixty dollars being, at that price the highest bidder for
 the same. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth, that the said
 William Mc Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court under
 and by virtue of the said decree and in consideration of the
 sum of three dollars paid by the said William Bates Thomas Mc
 Coy and Henry P Hammett the receipt whereof is hereby ackn-
 owledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by their
 presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 William Bates Thomas Mc Coy and Henry P Hammett and
 their heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land
