So that I am unable to labor for a support and have no means of support except from a tract of land on which I now reside, and wheras Jeremiah Bolling of said District & State agrees to support me the remainder of my natural life, I therefore know all men by these presents that I Lewis Batson of said District & State for and in consideration of the premises and also in the further consideration of Five dollars to me in hand paid by the said Jeremiah Bolling of said District and State have granted bargained sold and released & conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell release & convey unto the said Jeremiah Bolling all that piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the said District and State containing thirty seven acres more or less, being part of a tract of Fifty acres which had the following lines metes and bounds To wit, Beginning at a hickory 3 + 0 thence N 63 W 28.50 to a chestnut 3 + 0 thence N 31.58 to a small Chestnut
