Know all men by these presents that I Alfred Cargill of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy Five dollars to me paid by George W Bruce of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George W Bruce all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the south side of the Jordan road it being part of the tract when I now live beginning at a Pine stump on the south side of the Jordan Road and runs S 37 W 9.50 to a Black oak 3x3 thence N 44 W 37.83 to a Pine 3x3x3 at the head of a branch thence N 85 E 13.00 to a Stake 3x on the side of the Jordan road thence down the Jordan road to the beginning containing thirty Acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George W Bruce his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said George W Bruce his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
