


Morris Gosnell Deed South Carolina
 To For Greenville District
 W G Gosnell Land

Know all men by these presents that I Morris Gosnell of the State and District aforesaid for the Love and affection I have for my son W G Gosnell of the same State and District have given granted and conveyed and by these presents do give grant and convey unto the said W G Gosnell his heirs and assigns a tract or parcel of Land in the State and District aforesaid on both sides of South Packolletts River Beginning on a Spruce Pine Charles Gosnells corner thence N 16 1/2 E 2.60 to a Stake thence N 29. W 35. ch to Chesnut oak 3+ thence N 57 W 24.50 to a Chesnut 3+ thence N 60 W 1.50 to a Stake on a small branch thence Down the meander of the branch to a Mahogany 3+ thence S 34 W 7.50 ch to a Hickory 3+ thence S 57 E 37.00 ch to a S. Oak 3+ 3+ thence S 71 1/2 E 13.90 to the beginning containing by estimation seventy eight acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging to the same or in any wise incident or appertaining to it to have and hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W G Gosnell his heirs executors, administrators and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said W G Gosnell his heirs and assigns a gainst my self my heirs and assigns for and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal the 21st day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Fifty Eight " " Signed sealed and delivred in the presence of Anderson Pitman Daniel Harrison 3 Morris ^{his} Gosnell  mark

N B The condition of the within deed is that the said W G Gosnell is not to sell the said Land to any Disinterested person in my life time

 Anderson Pitman was a subscribing witness to the Execution
