Now know ye that I D Hooke Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statutes in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Two dollars and fifty cents to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said William B Johnson the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said W B Johnson his heirs and assigns
