 lands of James McEningy Mrs Cox & James Jackson part
 of a tract of land owned by John Miller deceased supposed
 to be about thirty seven acres more or less this instrument
 is intended to convey all our interest in the said premises
 to the said Katharine Hudgens her heirs & assigns forever
 together with all & singular all our right title & claim
 to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenant
 to the same against our selves our heirs & assigns
 unto the said Katharine Hudgens her heirs & assigns forever

Thence south 72° 8' 10' 25 links to a Stake black
