that I Thomas Steen of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand Dollars to me paid by Thomas A Holtzclaw of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas A Holtzclaw a certain Parcel or Tract of Land lying being and situate in Greenville District about eight miles from Greenville S C on the main Road leading from Greenville S C to Spartanburg and on the waters of Enore River being the same when in the late Jesse Shockly decd resided containing Two Hundred and twenty acres more or less and has marks and bounds as follows To wit, beginning at corner of Richard Ross Land running Thence N 47 E 45.32 to a Post Oak down, now a Stake Thence N 43 W 48.18 to a Stake Thence S 47 W 22.66 to a stake Thence W 47. E 6 to a Stake Thence S 47 W 22.66 to a Stake Thence S 43 E 51 to a Stake in the above conveyance there is reserved one acre of said Land as a family burial ground for the Heirs of Jesse Shockly deceased being one acre immediately around when Jesse Shockly deceased is now intended. Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas A Holtzclaw his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas A Holtzclaw his heirs and assigns against all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
