the State and District above written for and in consideration  
of the sum of Two thousand Five Hundred and fifty Two Dollars  
the payment of which is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained  
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
& release unto John S Bennett of the same State & District  
all that plantation and tract of land situated in the State  
and District aforesaid and on the waters of Little Needy  
Fork of Needy River and containing Four Hundred and sixty  
Four Acres be the same more or less, being part of a tract  
known as the thousand acre tract originally granted to the  
said M Berry and having the following marks & bound, Viz,  
Beginning on a Stone 3+ Tollisons 3+ & running thence N 49 1/4 E 56.75  
to a pine stump & stone 87 thence N 40 1/4 E 49.50 to a P.O. stump thence
