 State and District have granted bargained sold and released  
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
 said J P Pool a certain tract of land lying being and situated  
 in Greenville District two miles from Greenville Court House on  
 the Spartanburg road containing fifty acres as set out by metes  
 and bounds in a deed of conveyance to the said A W G Davis from  
 J P Pool with dower relinquishment dated February 28<sup>th</sup> 1863 and  
 recorded in the Clerks office of Greenville District in Register Messrs  
 Conveyance Book 7 Page 481 on the 5<sup>th</sup> March 1863 reference to  
 which deed is hereunto made as a part of this conveyance. So  
 have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto  
 the said J P Pool his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby  
 bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and  
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
 J P Pool his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and all  
 other persons whomsoever claiming by through or under me. It being  
 the intention of this deed to reconvey the title to said premises  
 only as it was vested in me by the conveyance aforesaid  
 Witness my hand and seal this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April in the  
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three
