

Now the condition of the above Deed is such, that if the aforesaid William Holder shall personally appear before the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas & General Sessions for the State and District aforesaid agreeable to the said Recognizance Bond and then and then to answer to a Bill of Indictment to be preferred against him the said William Holder for unlawful Distillation of Grain into Spirits & then this Deed of bargain and Sale shall cease, determine, and be utterly null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue

Whereas I Charles Cissom of the State aforesaid, and District of Greenville or of State of North Carolina and County Transylvania, wishing to save harmless J<sup>rs</sup> Hester & Simeon E<sup>rs</sup> Burgess, whom has signed a recognizance payable to the Confederate States of America for the appearance of William Holder at the next court of General Sessions to be holden at Pickens Court house on the third Monday in October next to answer to a bill of indictment to be preferred against him the said William Holder for the unlawful distillation of spirits Liquors or Spirits from grain and further that I the said Charles Cissom, wishing to save harmless of any damage to the said S<sup>rs</sup> Burgess & J<sup>rs</sup> Hester should said William Holder fail to attend said Court on his & their recognizance as before written - that for that intent to save harmless said Burgess & Hester - know all men by these presents that I Charles Cissom for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty (\$20) dollars to me in hand paid by the said Simeon E<sup>rs</sup> Burgess & J<sup>rs</sup> Hester the receipt whereof is her by acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain & release unto the said S<sup>rs</sup> Burgess & J<sup>rs</sup> Hester their heirs & assigns, all that tract piece parcel plantation and tract of land Lying & being in Greenville District & State of South Carolina & lying on Mathews
