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John M. Lynch do Hodges Davis & Co	Deed for Land	This Indenture made this the 31 st day of March 1860 between John M. Lynch of the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the first part and Davis W. Hodges John B. Davis and William J. Davis of the same District and State, the parties of the second part, Witnesseth, that the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars to him in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth give grant bargain sell and convey, and hath by these presents given granted bargain and sold and conveyed unto Davis W. Hodges John B. Davis and William J. Davis the parties aforesaid of the second part their heirs and assigns the following tract or parcel of land situated lying in the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on the waters of the North Fork of Saluda River, and being a part of the tract of land known as the late residence of John W. Hodges deer embracing the mill and Lanyard of said tract and hath the following boundary, beginning at a stone corner on the North side of the mill creek below the mill and in the line of J. S. Humphreys land, bearing North 15 West 27.50 chs to a stake in Humphreys line thence South 60 West 2.75 chs to a Post oak Humphreys line, thence South 68 1/2 West 11.43 chs to a large Poplar Humphreys corner on the east side of the State Road, thence with the State Road South 28 East 2.25 chs to a stake in the turn of the road, thence with the State road South 42 1/2 East 8.50 chs to the branch crossing the road thence with the said road South 30 East 7 chs to a stake thence with said road South 25 East 7.50 chs crossing the State Bridge to a stake, thence with said road South 55 East 6 chs to a stone corner, lower side of said road, thence to the beginning corner containing Twenty five acres more or less to have and to hold all and singular the rights and appertinances then unto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said Davis W. Hodges John B. Davis and William J. Davis their heirs or assigns forever, and the party of the first part doth further covenant and it is hereby covenanted that the parties of the second part are to enjoy the full and unobstruction passage of the mill creek through the land belonging to the party of the first part, and it is further agreed that the parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns shall
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
