 Enston certain attorney Executors and administrators or assigns
 to which payment well and truly to be made and done I bend
 myself and each and every of my heirs executors and admin-
 -istrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents
 sealed with my seal and dated the first day of July in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three
 and in the Eighty seventh year of the Sovereignty and Indep-
 -endence of the United States of America.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above
 bound James Mc Allen his heirs Executors or administrators
 shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the
 above named Mrs Mc Enston as her certain attorney Execu-
 -tors or administrators or assigns the full and just sum
 of One thousand Dollars on the first day of July one thous-
 -and Eight hundred and sixty eight with the interest
 semiannually at the rate of seven per cent per annum
 then the above obligation to be void and of none effect or
 else to remain in full force and virtue
