District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Nine thousand dollars, \$9000, to me paid by John Gadsden King of Charleston District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Gadsden King all that parcel and lot of land containing three fourths of an acre more or less, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate lying and being in the Town of Greenville in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid being bounded by Main Street on the West by Oak Street on the North by Brown Street on the East and by Judge Street on the South and being the same which was conveyed to me by C of Elford by Deed bearing date January 1856. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
