in consideration of the sum of Twenty three Hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Varday Mc Bee of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Varday Mc Bee his heirs & assigns four certain tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the District of Greenville State aforesaid on the waters of Brushy Creek of Needy River to wit, Tract No 1 containing Eighty acres more or less commencing on a Spanish Oak corner, and runs thence N 23 W 90 to a Red Oak thence N 70 E 130 to a stake pointer, thence S 26 E 92 to a stake thence S 34 W 70 to W Jacobs line thence with S Jacobs line N 35 W 8 to a corner of another tract hereofon, Thompsons corner thence N 32 W 41 to an old Maple stump or root on Brushy Creek thence along the line of another tract hereofon known as Thompsons line 66 poles to the beginning having hereofon been conveyed by the S. Mc Bee to W Alexander, Tract No 2, commencing at a stake corner at the ford of the creek and runs thence S 36 E 12.80 to a stake corner on Jacobs line thence S 63 W 41 to the corner thence S 40 W 11 to a Black oak
