 given three sealed notes of a thousand Dollars each \$1000 for one thousand

 to 25th Decr 1865. No 2 for one thousand dollars in specie or its

equivalent, dated 6th Decr 1865 due 25th Decr 1867 interest from date \$1000 for one thousand
 Dollars in specie or its equivalent dated 6th Decr 1865 due 25th Decr 1868 with interest from date
 Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Landy of Goodlett for and in consideration of
 the premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar by the said America
 Fowler to the said Landy of Goodlett in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery
 of these presents have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said America Fowler all that piece parcel or tract
 of land above described together with all and singular the rights premises hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said America Fowler his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby
 bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever
 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said America Fowler his
 heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever
 ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Provided always
 nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents

 for the same, it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Landy of Goodlett
