Thomas Esquire Commissioner of the honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District of Greenville County in the said State of the one part and Andrew Mc Hamilton Esquire of the other part Whereas Samuel W Williams and others on or about the fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight exhibited their bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville County in the said State against said W Williams and others for the partition of the tract of land of West Allen Williams deceased and the cause being at issue before the honorable Court came on to be heard at July Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight when the said Court after full hearing and mature deliberation in the premises did order and decree that said tract of land should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order as by reference made in the registry of the said Court will appear and the said Samuel W Williams as Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said Land for sale by public Auction on the fifteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of the said Land below described unto the said Andrew Mc Hamilton in the highest bid for the same Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said William Mc Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said decree and in consideration of the sum of three dollars paid him by the said Andrew Mc Hamilton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said Andrew Mc Hamilton and his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in Greenville District containing three hundred and ninety seven acres more or less commencing at a stake on the N. E. corner of the lot of the late John Mc Williams and running N. 75° E. 1/4 mile to the beginning corner according to Plat annexed together with all and singular the hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in anywise appertaining and the revenues and remainders unto issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest down possession property benefit claim and demand whatsoever both at law and equity of the heirs and representatives of the said West Allen Williams and of the parties to this deed and of all other parties rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by from or under them or either of them to have and to hold the said Land with its hereditaments privileges and appurtenances unto the said Andrew Mc Hamilton his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use benefit and behoof forever
