Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises to the said William James Montgomery his heirs and assigns forever and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William James Montgomery against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
