 and eight hundred and fifty two between James P. Moore Esquire
 Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at
 Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part and Lima
 Cannon of the other part Whereas Prudence Gill widow of George
 Gill deceased et al on or about the Eighteenth day of January in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six exhibited
 their Bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court
 House in the said State against James Ross et al, and the cause being
 at issue before the honorable Court came on to be heard at Chambers
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six
 when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation
 in the premises did order adjudge and decree that the Real Estate
 of George Gill deceased as described in the Bill should be divided
 and assigned amongst the parties in interest as recommended by
 the Commissioners in Partition and whereas the said Commissioners
 in Partition did assign Lot No 8 containing Forty two acres more
 or less and valued at seven thousand and fifty five Dollars to Lima
 Cannon, Now therefore this indenture witnesseth that the said James P.
 Moore as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree
 and in consideration of the sum of three Dollars paid him by the said Lima Can-
 on the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sell and
 released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 Lima Cannon her heirs and assigns all that tract or Lot of Land Situate in
 Greenville District and State aforesaid on the North side of South Eggo River
 beginning at a point on said River marked by a stone & running N 74°
 E 35.50 to a stone & n. thence S 60° 45' W 8.55 to Hickory & p. o. n. thence S 66°
 W 22.50 to a stone on said River thence along said River to the beginning corner and
 containing Forty two acres more or less as per plat of James P. Dickson
 Esq. hereto attached, together with all and singular the hereditaments right
 members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in anywise
 appertaining, and the reversions and remainders unto issues and profits thereof
 and also all the estate right title interest down possession property benefit

claim and demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the heirs and representatives
 of the said George Gill deceased and of the parties to this deed and of all other persons
 rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by given or under them or
 either of them. To have and to hold the said Land with its hereditaments privileges
 and appurtenances unto the said Lima Cannon her heirs and assigns to her and
 theirs only proper use benefit and behoof forever
