Goodlett on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of July One thousand eight hundred and forty eight 1848  
and recorded in Register Messrs Comyners Book Page 478 and conveyed  
to me by William H. Goodlett dec'd in his last will and Testament  
together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appur-

on the North side of the Washy Bridge Road 42 feet from Isaac Parsie's corner  
and 15 feet from the center of the road and runs thence 87 1/2 chains 82 links  
to a stake or 1/2<sup>nd</sup> thence North 30 1/2<sup>nd</sup> E 8 chains 50 links to a stake or 1/2<sup>nd</sup>  
thence South 87 1/2<sup>nd</sup> E 11 chains 58 links crossing a small branch to a stake or 1/2<sup>nd</sup>  
from the center of the before mentioned Road thence up said Road 15 feet from
