The conditions of the above obligation is such that if the said Frances Turner & Missourable Turner shall support and maintain the said Alfred Turner & Arrena Turner his wife during their natural life time and also to support Joseph H. Turner during the life time of the said Alfred Turner & Arrena Turner and also to support Clary Turner & Narcisia Turner their daughters until they have arrived to the age of twenty one years and when Clary Turner & Narcisia Turner have arrived to the age of twenty one years then the said Frances Turner & Missourable Turner shall give them each a Bed and furniture and at the death of the said Alfred Turner & Arrena Turner his wife then the said Frances Turner & Missourable Turner shall sell all the property which I have deeded to them & divide the proceeds of the said equally between themselves and all their brothers and sisters so as to make them all equal with the express understanding
