Crutwell and last such marks and bounds as follows beginning at a stake on the said old State road running N 71° E 10 chs along said road to rock corner thence N 59° E 45.95 chs to stake on the dividing said tract and Gilmathie land thence along said dividing line N 55° W 15 chs to Pine corner of Edwards land thence S 49° W 12.95 chs to R. O. thence N 66° W 1.05 chs to stake corner of a piece of land recently purchased by said William Moon from M.
