 William A B Devenport of the said State and District
 of the other part, Witness the Men as the said William A B
 Devenport hath to come and is the surety of the said Isaac
 Devenport to Hewlett Sullivan upon a note for seven hundred
 dollars dated about April 13th 1861 upon which one hundred
 dollars was paid about May 26th 1863, and whereas the said
 Isaac Devenport desired to save and indemnify the said
 William A B Devenport against loss or damage by reason
 of his said suretyship, Now the Indenture witnesseth that
 the said Isaac Devenport for and in consideration of the prem-
 ises aforesaid, and for the better securing and indemnifying
 the said William A B Devenport against loss or damage by
 reason of the said suretyship, and also in consideration of the
 sum of four dollars to the said Isaac Devenport by the said
 William A B Devenport in hand paid at and before the sealing
 and delivery of this present, doth grant bargain sell assign
 release convey and confirm unto the said William A B Deven-
 port and to his heirs and assigns forever all that piece parcel
 and tract of land containing One thousand and fifty acres
 more or less situate lying and being in the District of
 Greenville and Part aforesaid, and adjoining lands of
 William Anderson James Anderson Dr. James Thomas and
 others being made up of lands purchased by the said Isaac
 Devenport from William Healed Estate of Widow Healed and
 being known and called as the Healed Place together with
 all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining, and the premises and

reversions, remainder and remainders rents issues and profits
 thereof to have and to hold the said tract of land with the
 appurtenances unto the said William A B Devenport his heirs
 and assigns forever, Provided always never the less and
