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said in consideration of the sum of thirty four \$5 dollars to me paid by H Army Mason of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said H Army Mason a certain parcel or tract of land situated in the State and District aforesaid on a branch of Rocky Creek of Enoree River and having such marks and boundaries as follows Beginning on a Walnut 34 near the dam on my place thence S 87 1/4 E 11.25 to a stone 34 thence S 31 1/2 W 10.50 to a Holly 34 thence N 32 W 11.20 to the beginning corner containing five acres more or less and with the right of using the water from the dam on my place for the purpose of a distillery together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to them and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said H Army Mason and her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said H Army Mason and his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

 by Willis & John Benson to John de Lopez and recorded in books
 office Book 2 Page 272, as land conveyed to the said Willis and John
 Benson by William Mc Goodlett bounded on south by lands of J M
 Brooks West by J G Westfield East of the Augusta road commencing
 at a stake on said road south of the house & running thence
