Adjoining lands of Elijah Pike and others containing twenty two acres be there more less beginning on a stone 34 and running N 28° W 12.50 to a chestnut 34 thence N 67° W 18.75 to a stone 34 thence S 28° E 11.00 to a pine 34 thence N 66.819 to a stone at the beginning. To have and to hold all the aforesaid premises hereditaments rights title and appurtenances to the same or in anywise incident or belonging thereto unto the only use of the said Edward F King his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the said premises from myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns and against every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
