to the said G W Morse his heirs and assigns all my claim and title
in and to the mortgaged estate therein mentioned, having received
full satisfaction for the debt thereby secured

Thomas Henry M. Carl and Sophia F. Carl his wife on or about
the Ninth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and sixty six exhibited their bill of complaint in the Court
of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against Mrs
Emily E. Beattie et al and the cause being at issue before the
Honorable Court came on to be heard at July Term in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six when the said Court
after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did
order and judge and decree that the Real Estate of Mrs Emily E. Rowland
deceased in the pleadings should be sold at public auction by the Com-
missioner of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned
in their decretal Order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said
Court will appear and the said Gas P. Moon as Commissioner of the
said Court after having advertised the said Real Estate for sale by Public
Auction on the first Monday of October in the year of our Lord one thousand

Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said Gas P. Moon
as Commissioner of the said Court under and by Order of the said Court
and in consideration of the sum of three Dollars paid him by the said
Mary C Spear the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto
the said Mary C Spear her heirs and assigns all that lot or parcel of land
situate lying and being in the corporate limits of the Town of Greenville on
the west side of the Remondin Road being the town and lot whereon Mrs
Emily E. Rowland resided at the time of her death adjoining lots of Henry
M. Carl and others containing three acres being Lot No 2 as described in
the pleadings and in the return of the Commissioners in partition of the
Estate of Mrs Emily E. Rowland deceased. Together with all and singular the
hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said lot belonging
or in anywise appertaining and the revenues and remainments issues and
profits thereof and also all the estate right title interest dower possession
property benefit claim and demand whatsoever both at law and Equity of the
heirs and representatives of the said Emily E. Rowland deceased and of the
parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof by force or under them or either of them so
have and to hold the said lot with its hereditaments privileges and appur-
tenances unto the said Mary C Spear her heirs and assigns to her and their
