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I know all men by their presents that I John Johnson for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my daughter Elija Glenn and also in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to me in hand paid have given granted bargained sell and released, and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and release unto Frances A Johnson in trust for the sole separate and exclusive use of my daughter Elija Glenn and her children the following named property to wit One Tract of Land situated on Long Creek waters of Needy River bounded by lands of Henry Glenn Gilly Clark Elija Leagu and Dr N Austin, also one carriage one waggon and horses one hundred and twenty bushels of corn one thousand bundles of fodder two pens of hucks and straw eleven head of hogs two head of cattle four head of sheep one mare kitchenhold and kitchen furniture and all the increase of the property abovementioned. To have and to hold the above property in trust nevertheless for the use and benefit of the said Elija Glenn and her children and not be subject to the debts liabilities and contracts of her present husband or any future husband she may have. And the said Trustee is to have full power and authority to sell and dispose of any of the above property when it is deemed advisable for the support and maintenance of the said Elija Glenn and her children and invest the proceeds of said sale in other property for the use and benefit of Elija Glenn subject to the same trust as above. The Trustee must first get the consent of Elija Glenn before the property can be sold.
