of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged doth  
give and grant Bargain sell and convey and hath by these presents  
given granted Bargained sold and Conveyed unto the party aforesaid of  
the second part his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land  
situate lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the  
Beaver Branch Creek waters of North Saluda river and includes  
the North Eastern portion of the house tract allotted to said  
party of the first part as his claims. Beginning on the North line
