 This Indenture made this fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven between *Sy Doughty* ordinary of the District aforesaid and *Solomon Pitman* of the same State and District Whereas a writ of summons to divide or sell a certain tract of Land since after described of the Estate of *John H. Harrison* of said District deceased issued from the Court of Ordinary of said District and upon the return thereof the Judge of said Court did determine that the said Land could not be divided without injury to the parties interested and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the District aforesaid on a credit of five months with interest from the day of sale, whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said Land for sale on the first Monday in May in the year above mentioned and whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry aforesaid the said Land when the said *Solomon Pitman* was the last and highest bidder so that the said Land was struck off for the sum of seventy five Dollars Now this Indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of seventy five dollars to me paid and to be paid I have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said *Solomon Pitman* and his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of Land situated in said District on waters of Wild Cat Creek bounded by lands of *George Harrison* & *W Jackson* and others and containing seventy five acres more or less Together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging and all the estate right title interest claim or demand which the said *John H. Harrison* deceased at the time of his death had in or to the same to have and to hold the said tract of Land together with all and singular the premises improvements and appurtenances to the said *Solomon Pitman* his heirs and assigns forever

 I know all men by these presents that *Lawrence O Williams* of State of South Carolina and District of Anderson in consideration of One thousand Dollars to me paid by *James M David* of State aforesaid and District of Anderson have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said *James M David* all that tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and ten acres more or less situated lying and being in State aforesaid and District of Greenville on waters of Gold-cut Groom creek waters of Saluda River adjoining lands belonging to *B H Johnson Isaac Charles & Farmer* and aforesaid *M David* and having the following lines metes and bounds Beginning on a Stake 34 and thence N 87 1/2 W 101 1/2 40 to a Stake 34 thence S 1/4 W 101 1/2 70 to a Stake 34 then S 77 1/2 W 11 30 to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises before mentioned belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said *James M David* his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said *James M David* his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
