Moor Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part and Malinda P. McBride of the other part Minnie Vardry McBride and Alexander McBride Executors of the last will and testament of Vardry McBride deceased on or about the twenty ninth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty six Exhibit to them file of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State against Malinda P. McBride et al. and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at July Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberations in the premises did Order Adjudged and Decree that in certain portions of the real estate of Vardry McBride deceased (as recommended by the Commissioners in partition) should be conveyed by the Commissioners of the said Court and the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their Recited Order as by reference made in the Registry of the said Court will appear to Malinda P. McBride. Now therefore this indenture witnesseth that the said James P. Moor as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars paid him by the said Malinda P. McBride the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that she granted Bargained sold and Released unto by these Presents unto her said Bargained and Released unto

the said Malinda P. McBride her Heirs and Assigns and undivided half (1/2) of what is described in the writ of Partition in Lat. No. 3, and known as the Horse lot in the Town of Greenville and more particularly described by a plat here to attached, together with all and singular the Hereditament Rights Members and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Lands belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the Reversions and Remainders Herits Issues and Profits thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Power Possession Property Benefit Claim and Demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the Heirs and Representatives of the said Vardry McBride deceased and of the parties to this suit and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the said or any part thereof by force or under them or either of them to have and to hold the said Land with its Hereditaments Privileges and Appurtenances unto the said Malinda P. McBride her Heirs and Assigns to her and them only proper use benefit and behoof forever. In witness whereof the said James P.
