Moore as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of three Dollars paid him by the said Alexander McRee the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted sold and Released and by these presents doth Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the said Alexander McRee his Heirs and Assigns Four undivided fifths (1/5th) of what is herein and directed in the Trust of partition and the return of the Commissioners as the hereinafter appears and as tract No 18 containing one thousand and fourteen acres more or less and more particularly described in the plat of the same annexed hereto together with all and singular the Hereditaments Rights Members Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in anywise appertaining and the Reversions and Remainders Rents Issues and Profits thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Power Possession Property Benefit Claim and Demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of the Heirs and Representatives of the said Varday McRee deceased and of the parties to this deed and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by force or under them or either of them to have and to hold the said Land with the said Hereditaments Tenements and Appurtenances unto the said Alexander McRee his Heirs and Assigns to him and their only proper heirs benefits and behoof forever In witness whereof the said James P. Moore as Commissioner of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree hath hereunto set his Hand and the seal of the Court on the day and year first above written separate sealed and delivered in the presence of
